LUXEMBOURG TRADE AND COMPANIES REGISTER ("RCS"): MODIFICATIONS AS OF NOVEMBER 12, 2024

Starting from November 12th, 2024, the current requisition forms in PDF format will be replaced by forms to be completed directly online, in HTML format.

Alongside the implementation of the new HTML forms and pursuant to article 12bis of the amended law of 19 December 2002 on RCS and the accounting and annual accounts of companies (the "Law") individuals and entities registered with the RCS shall communicate the national identification number ("LNIN") of any individual entered in the RCS. This will for example apply to all individuals listed in a company's creation deed (shareholders, directors and auditors, etc.) and registered with the RCS.

- Individuals who already have a LNIN will simply have to indicate it during the filing process, it being precised that all individuals already registered with the RCS before the implementation of the new HTLM forms will also have to indicated their LNIN.
- Individuals who do not have a LNIN shall be allocated one in accordance with article 1, paragraph 2, subparagraph 2 of the amended law of 19 June 2013 on the identification of natural persons when they are registered by the manager of the RCS.

In addition to the information required in relation to the filing process, each individual who requires the creation of a LNIN will have to submit additional documents and information concerning his nationality, his gender and his private address. Supporting documents are requested to confirm the information and the Luxembourg Business Registers (LBR) will check them.

Pursuant to the article 12ter of the Law, Luxembourg private addresses to be entered in the RCS shall mention (i) the locality, (ii) the street, (iii) the number of the building appearing or to be communicated in the National Register of Localities and Streets and (iv) the postal code.
